

Dear Erasmus Student,

you have to go for a **Medical Check Up** including a chest X-ray, a laboratory / blood test and a general check up by the University Doctor in order to get your Certificate from the University verifying your Medical Fitness.

The basis of these examinations are the documents that you have brought with you from your country (Hepatitis C test, Hepatitis B vaccination card, HIV test, Dyslexia test). The University Doctor will send you for further laboratory test if needed.

The **general examination** will take place at the building of the University Doctor (Department of Family Medicine/Tisza Lajos krt 109.).

General examination

fee: 6,000.00 HUF

You have to go there on the day appointed by the doctor.

After the general examination the University Doctor will issue you for the chest X-ray and the blood test if it is needed. After they received your results they will provide you the Certificate about your Medical Fitness for this academic year.

Chest X-ray result taken from the student's home country can also be accepted but in case of any controversy the examination may have to be repeated.

The chest X-ray will take place at the New Clinic (*Euromedic Diagnostics*, 1st floor).
