

Dear Student,

We have been informed about your nomination by your home university coordinator and we can accept it.

As for the first step you are asked to register on DreamApply (online system for applying):

The first step is that you have to choose your country of origin, which can be found on the right side on the top of the page.

Within the Exchange Incoming Erasmus+ Studies you have to click on 'Find programmes' and select **'Exchange incoming' in case of studies**

or

'Traineeship Incoming' in case of traineeships.

Please also choose the semester and 'part time' studies there.

Please submit the following documents of the application procedure on the platform (a checklist will help you there to follow your application process):

- Learning Agreement form (signed by you and your home coordinator. You don't have to get your host coordinator's signature on it, as he/she will sign it on DreamApply).
- language certificate in B2 in the language of your studies /you are also required to provide it as part of the application/

These 2 documents above must be uploaded until **01 June 2025, which is the application deadline for the 1st semester and the whole academy year of 2025/26.**

The documents detailed below must be uploaded until 10 August 2025:

- Erasmus status certificate (written in English, issued by your home institution incl. the following data: the name of your university, that you will study at our university as an exchange student within the Erasmus Programme, the dates of your study period (from ; to), **the amount of your grant (in EUR).**
- passport or ID card (must be valid for at least 6 months after your return home)
- travel insurance valid for the whole period of your stay in Szeged
- a valid European Health Insurance Card (for EU-citizens)
