for the academic year 2025/2026.

The following types of mobility applications should be submitted to the International Mobility Centre by email to Katalin BALÁZS balazs.katalin@szte.hu by the departmental and faculty coordinators by **Friday, 19 September, 2025 at 11:59 p.m.** at the latest:

- Teaching, training and research mobilities

Eligible activities

Staff mobilities

Teaching, training, research mobilities:

- Training mobilities (2-60 days): eligible period: 1 week
- Teaching mobilities (2 days – 60 days): eligible period: 1 week
- Research mobilities (2–60 days): eligible period: may be longer than 1 week, in which case a detailed research plan approved by the person leading the research must be submitted (e.g., if the minimum duration of experimental equipment use is longer than 1 week)

In this call for applications, all outgoing teachers in the 2025/2026 academic year may undertake two teaching, training, or research mobility activities, while non-teaching staff may undertake one training mobility activity, not including teaching/training mobilities for officially announced EUGLOH project events at EUGLOH partner institutions. Part-time and volunteer contract employees are eligible for support for one mobility opportunity, depending on the available budget.

Applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their applications.

Predictable, eligible costs:

- scholarship;

Support for 2 travel days may also be granted if the days of the physical mobility do not coincide with the travel days, this must be proven by a travel document (e.g. plane ticket, bus ticket, train ticket, etc.) or a criminal law declaration (eg. in case of travel by car).

Mobility is also possible for countries not included in the country groups - please contact the International Mobility Centre for the classification of these countries.

Grants for teaching, training and research mobilities (depending on the target country):

- 1-15 days: 70.000/60.000/50.000 HUF/day
- 16-30 days: 46.200/39.600/33.000 HUF/day
- from 31. day: 23.100/19.800/16.500 HUF/day

Application information

1. Eligibility of applicants

Teaching/administrative/research mobilities: only full-time employees of the University of Szeged are eligible to apply. Part-time and volunteer contract employees are eligible for support for one mobility opportunity, depending on the available budget.

2. Eligible countries and partner institutions

With the support of the Pannonia Scholarship Program, applications can be submitted to any country in the world, provided that the University of Szeged has signed a cooperation agreement with a university in that country. In the case of research scholarships, mobility may also take place at institutions other than higher education institutions (e.g., research institutes), in which case no inter-institutional agreement is required.

The University of Szeged prioritises mobility to EUGLOH partner institutions (*Université de Paris-Saclay, Ludwig-Maximilian-Universität München, University of Porto, University of Lund, Universität Hamburg, University of Novi Sad, Universidad de Alcalá, Universitetet i Tromsø*).

3. Application conditions

- The sending and host higher education institutions are ECHE certified, except training and research mobilities.
- Number of teaching hours: at least 8 hours per week, but also at least 8 hours for periods shorter than 1 week (even for a minimum of 2 days).
- Location: cannot be in the country of the sending institution or the country of residence.
- The outgoing participant shall follow the individual work program submitted in their application, approved by the parties concerned and accepted with their signatures.
- **Support for 2 travel days may also be granted if the days of the physical mobility do not coincide with the travel days, this must be proven by a travel document (e.g. plane ticket, bus ticket, train ticket, etc.) or a criminal law declaration (eg. in case of travel by car).**

Mobility support can only be calculated for the duration of physical, onsite mobility.

4. The application process

Mobility applications are announced and evaluated by faculty and department coordinators based on the central call for applications issued by the University of Szeged. Supported applications must be submitted by **Friday, September 19, 2025, at 11:59 p.m.**, exclusively by email to Katalin Balázs balazs.katalin@szte.hu.
