2026/2027 ACADEMIC YEAR
WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE
PANNONIA GUEST LECTURER
PROGRAM**

The aim of this part of the program is to provide opportunities for lecturers from internationally top-ranked institutions to come to Hungary, thereby raising the international recognition and embeddedness of the host institutions.

Nominations for guest lecturers for the scholarship must be sent by departmental and faculty coordinators to the International Mobility Centre at balazs.katalin@szte.hu by midnight on Tuesday, February 24, 2026, at the latest.

Eligible Activities

Educational Mobility (1-6 months)

- The Pannonia Guest Lecturer Program provides the opportunity to host lecturers from foreign higher education institutions that rank in the top 250 in the Times Higher Education and Quacquarelli Symonds international higher education rankings. The Sponsor may also approve, upon special request, the acceptance of foreign higher education institutions listed in the subject rankings as institutions of excellence based on the Sponsor's guidelines.
- The Pannonia Guest Lecturer Program allows for mixed mobility under the following conditions:
 - The overall physical mobility component cannot be shorter than the minimum supported duration, nor can it exceed the maximum length.
 - Housing and travel support is available to participants during the physical mobility period.
 - Personnel costs can be supported proportionally, for a maximum of 6 months in the case of mixed mobility.

Support Amounts

Budgetable, Reimbursable Costs:

- Personnel costs (related to the guest lecturer's work – based on actual incurred costs);
- Travel support (based on actual incurred costs);
- Housing support (based on actual incurred costs).

The above costs associated with hosting a guest lecturer do not have a maximum limit; however, a maximum of 10,000,000 HUF can be reimbursed for each guest lecturer from the total of the listed support items, provided that the overall physical mobility component cannot be shorter than the minimum supported duration, nor can it exceed the maximum length.

Under the travel support, only the costs of one round trip can be reimbursed, which occurs between the sending institution's headquarters or the guest lecturer's place of residence/stay and the host (beneficiary) institution's city.

The reimbursement of personnel, housing, and travel support provided under the Pannonia Guest Lecturer Program is based on actual incurred costs, as its aim is to cover all expenses incurred by the invited guest lecturer. Considering this, the guest lecturer must itemize the support paid to them. The payment process can be determined by the beneficiary sending institution at its discretion.

Required Supporting Documents

- For personnel costs:
 - A contract with the hosting (beneficiary) institution that includes the amount of personnel compensation and the duration of the guest lecturer's appointment.
 - Supporting documents related to the payment of the support.
- For travel support:

- Original invoices documenting the actual incurred travel costs.
- Other supporting documents and records.
- Travel Documents: (ticket, boarding pass, etc.) that can establish the date(s) of travel.
- A contract with the guest lecturer that justifies the payment of the support.
- Supporting documents related to the payment of the support.

- For Housing Support:
 - A copy of the contract with the housing provider, which includes the costs of housing and the period during which the service was utilized.
 - Receipts for payments related to housing.
 - A contract with the guest lecturer that justifies the payment of the support.
 - Supporting documents related to the payment of the support.

Application Information

1. Eligibility

Guest Lecturer Mobility: The Pannonia Guest Lecturer Program allows for the hosting of lecturers from foreign higher education institutions that rank in the top 250 in the Times Higher Education and Quacquarelli Symonds international higher education rankings. The Sponsor may also approve, upon special request, the acceptance of foreign higher education institutions listed in the subject rankings as institutions of excellence based on the Sponsor's guidelines.
