### The host company

### Role

Supporting the engineering department within the company, this role will be focused on working alongside the current technician to perform day to day functions around CAD drawing editing, creating new drawings for client 'specials' after taking a full brief and determining the correct needs. Liaising with the manufacturing team to understand what is possible before creating suitable drawings. Helping develop revenue capabilities, using equipment already installed within the company to maximise asset utilisation, including a Robot.
