Catalan Philology students will be given priority</li><li>3. Students must be fluent in Catalan (C1-C2 level preferred, B2 accepted) and in English (native, C1 or C2 level). Knowledge of Spanish and other languages will be taken into account</li><li>4. Intercultural awareness and strong communication skills also required</li></ol>
