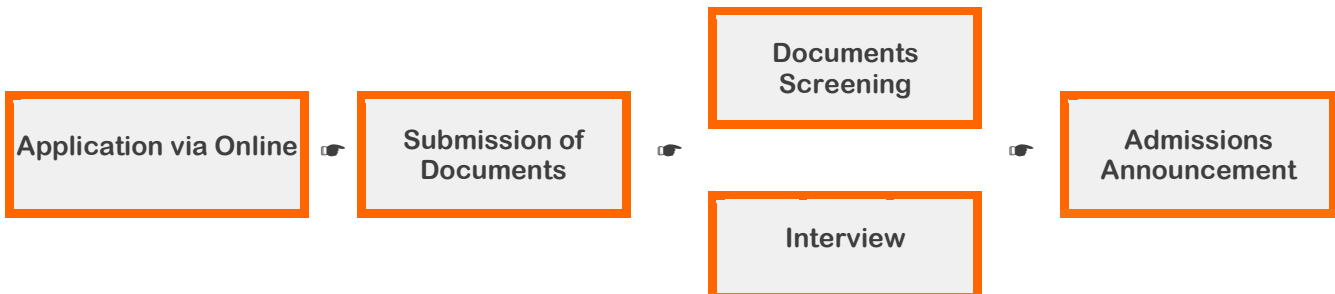

- Applicants whose graduation from undergraduate/graduate is pending during the time of application must submit their Graduation Certificates of Degrees by Feb.29, 2012(Wed)
- When those who graduated from overseas universities or graduate school submit a certificate of graduation and school transcript, they must obtain an Apostille or an official endorsement from the applicant's country embassy (with complete marks printed on the transcript)
- Those who apply for Transfer have to submit the certificate of Graduation, Enrollment and Transcript (notarization in English or Korean) from Previous Univ.

International students who get admission as international admission by submitting TOPIK level 3 must submit the score report of TOPIK level 4 before graduation, or graduation is not permitted.(It is independent to foreign language test for graduation of graduate school)

### 3. Insurance(Mandatory)

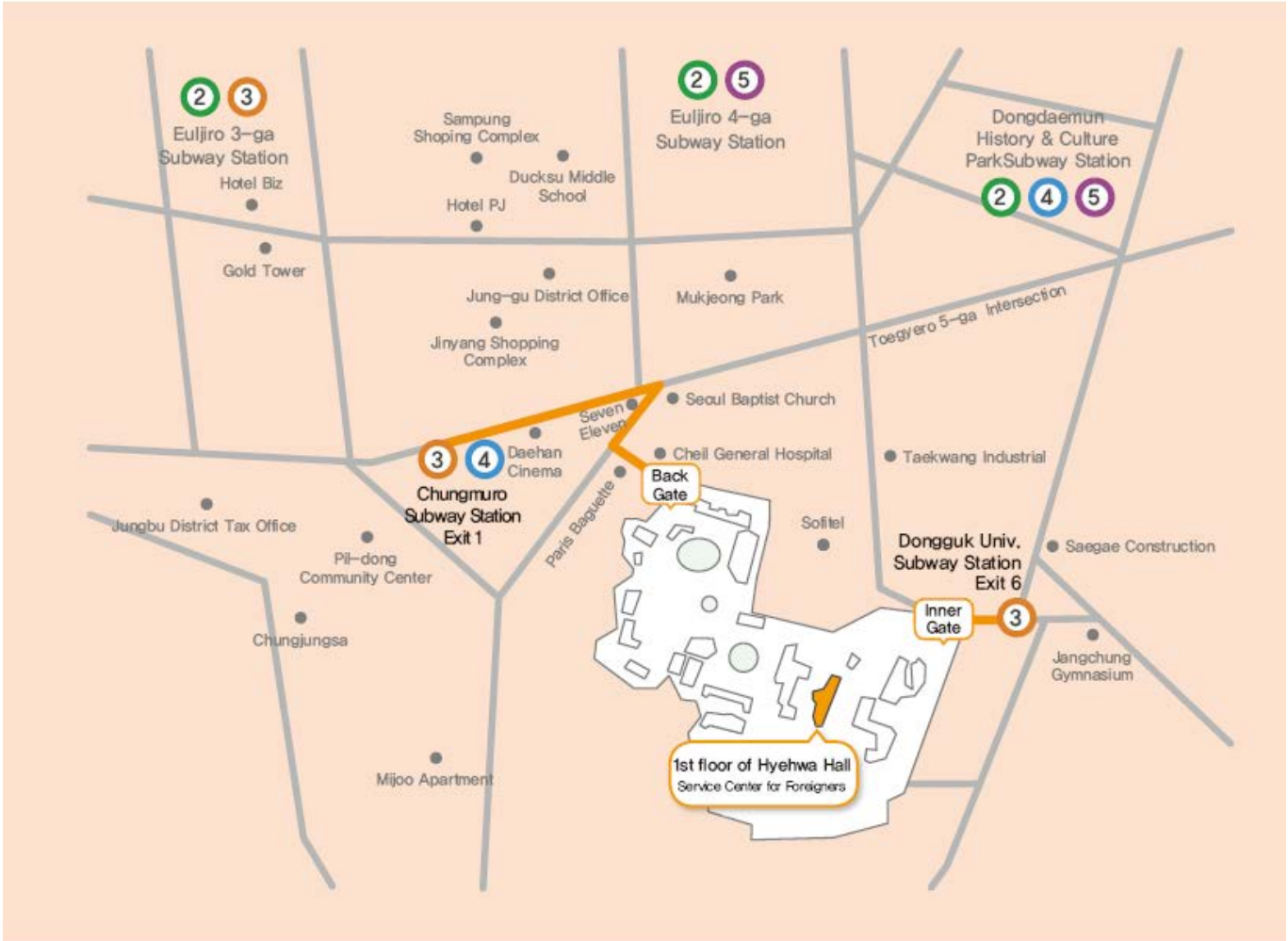
- Health insurance is obligatory for every international student who is accepted to Dongguk University (fee amount: approximately 150,000KRW per year)
