The Hungary Initiatives Foundation invites interested individuals to apply for grants to participate at workshops or conferences in Hungary or in the U.S.

Eligibility

- The application is open to Hungarian citizens (with a permanent residence in Hungary) for conferences held in the US and American permanent residents or citizens for conferences held in Hungary
- The applicant must give an oral or poster presentation at the conference
- The applicant must be associated with an academic or research institution in the US or in Hungary or must be delegates who are not fully funded by industry

Available grant

- Applicants can request funding up to \$3,000 per conference participation
- Grant can be used for registration fee and travel expenses, including lodging

- Curriculum Vitae
- Proof of acceptance for the presentation
- Detailed budget
- For students, researchers, fellows, interns: reference letter from supervisor
