All students are required to pay the housing deposit in the amount of \$225 (USD). Exchange students are usually housed on the downtown campus in dorm facilities. If students live on campus, they are also required to choose a meal plan. Those not required to live on-campus are encouraged to live in our off-campus university apartment complexes. All students are required to pay deposit in the amount of \$400 (USD). Our on-campus facilities do not provide linens for the rooms.</p>
