Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Applicants must hold student status with our partner universities within the V4 group of nations at the time of application and throughout the entire period of the scholarship. Failure to maintain student status will result in suspension of the scholarship. ● Applicants must be enrolled as undergraduate students (full time in residence). ● High motivation and high level of academic performance. ● Recommendation by the university in which applicants are enrolled. ● Applicants must be available to start classes in September ● Applicants enrolled are expected to take Japanese Language Courses.
Duration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Duration of the scholarship is one academic year (two semesters) starting in September. Scholarships can neither be extended nor renewed.
Other Points to Consider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The recipient of the scholarship may be assigned to either of the universities and any of the faculties listed above. ● The scholarship can be revoked if the grantee fails to attend classes regularly or if JU/JIU feels that the grantee is not maintaining standards required by the scholarship. ● The student will be expected to show enthusiasm to engage in academic and cultural events related to JU/JIU. ● All grantees must enroll in the Japanese National Health Insurance plan during their stay in Japan (premium is approximately 20,000 yen per year). ● The cost of textbooks will be approximately 30,000 yen per semester. ● Students are expected to pay for their own meals.

Application Procedure

Required documents must be submitted electronically, preferably as a PDF file, to josai-exch@jiu.ac.jp by no later than April 10, 2020 (No hard copies necessary).

Required Documents:

- Application form (Please note, “4. Endorsement by the Home Institution” needs to be signed by an authorized person of the home university, e.g. Rector, Dean, etc.)
- Recommendation letters from two instructors of the student’s home university
- Application essay
- Transcript of academic records from the student’s home university

(Important Notes)

- Our mail system will not accept files larger than 10MB (depending on how your mail is routed, smaller files may also be rejected before reaching us). We advise you to kindly send each application separately, to compress files before attaching, and / or to use an outside storage system.
- We have noticed several cases where scanning process was not properly executed. Please recheck the result of scan before sending.

Selection Procedure

(1). Examination of application by Josai and Josai International University (April / May).

We ask the applicants to express their commitment to hard work, and to use this opportunity to enhance their future career possibilities. Also, we hope that they will work in some capacity as a bridge of good will between the two countries in the future. Other various factors, such as field of study, language ability, balance of the number of students among the home universities of applicants, etc. may be considered.

(2). Students will receive the result of selection from Josai via their home university (late May).

Students should then contact the Center for International Education of the university they are assigned to (e-mail address will be included in the notice of selection).

(3). Students to arrive in Japan (September).
