I am writing regarding the International Summer School at the University of Exeter to say that we are excited to open our application window on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November 09:00 am GMT. We are aiming for the programme to back on campus next summer and are very excited about it already but are also looking at potential hybrid options and will look to move the course online if the situation requires it.

Our International Summer School has been running for over ten years and steadily growing in size and we are delighted to say that we now have courses from five of our six colleges in the areas below with some new additions for this year!

- Adapting Cognitive Behavioural Therapy to Improve Access to Psychological Therapies
- Britain and the Making of the Modern World
- British Cultures
- Contract Law
- Engineering Biology
- Global Climate Change: Science, the Environment & Society
- Human Rights Law
- International Relations: Security, Conflict & Peace
- Preventive Medicine: Exercise and the Environment
- Project Management
- Rethinking Shakespeare: Beyond the Bard
- Theatre: Applied Puppetry
- Victorian Decadents, Degenerates, Goths and Global Citizens

The programme start date for 2022 is set as 30<sup>th</sup> June – 21<sup>st</sup> July 2022. Within the programme, students have the chance to study up to 2 accredited courses worth 7.5 ECTS each as well as undertake a Global Challenge, explore the UK on day trips, experience London during our 4 day orientation trip and take part in an engaging social programme designed to help people make friends from all over the world.

The full programme fee is £2,500 for one course and £3,250 for two courses and includes all accommodation, airport transfers and all other programme transport for field trips and day trips, the social programme and all registration and academic fees. The accommodation is self-catered, but students can choose to pay for meal vouchers on campus for breakfast and lunch, and some dinners are also provided as part of the social programme.

Scholarships contributions of £500 are also available for the programme for any students who apply and are able to evidence a current GPA of 3.7 or above. If you believe that you may have a group of interested students, we would be delighted to offer a group discount rate of £500 per person in recognition of our partnership. For any details on potential scholarships, please do reply to me on this email address as we may be able to be more flexible as the year progresses.

Our application window will remain open until 13<sup>th</sup> May 2021 but places will be awarded on a first come first serve basis. I am also extremely excited to be able to announce our upcoming Sustainability Summer Programme which will happen alongside the International Summer School. We anticipate the opening of the application window for this programme to be around 15<sup>th</sup> November and will be sending out another email specifically about this programme once all details are finalised.
